The Northwestern R-I School District is seeking a certified instructor to fill the position of Family and Consumer Sciences (FACS) Teacher for the 2025-2026 School Year due to a retirement. The successful candidate will demonstrate diverse professional knowledge, a vision of excellence, a student-centered focus, and a positive team-oriented attitude. At this time we will only consider certified applicants or those that will have certification completed by December 2025.

Northwestern operates on a 4-day school week. This is a 9-month certified position (156 contracted days). The starting salary minimum is \$40,000 or \$46,000 for those with a Master's Degree + 10 years of experience.

Northwestern is located in Mendon, MO and has a PreK-12 student population of 150 and a staff of 50 including certified and classified positions. The district offers a competitive salary schedule and benefits including Board paid health insurance supplement (\$600 per month), life insurance and retirement match are available to applicable positions. All staff member children have free tuition (for those that live outside of district boundaries) and are provided with free Before/After School Childcare onsite.
